THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 4122

A BY-LAW to acquire certain lands for highway purposes.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY LAND ACQUISITION BY-LAW NO. 2, 1960."
- 2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owners thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, in consideration of the sum of Eleven Hundred (\$1,100) Dollars, those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia, and more particularly known and described as that portion of Lot 15, Block 33, District Lot 187, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 1282.
