BY-LAW NO. 4124

A BY-LAW to amend By-law No. 3477, being the "Burnaby Street and Traffic By-law 1954".

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY STREET AND TRAFFIC BY-LAW 1954, AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1960".
- 2. By-law No. 3477 is amended by adding the following as Section 44B:-
- "hthe. (1) No person shall drive or operate a motor vehicle upon any lane or way separating the rear property-lines of parcels of land fronting on highways running more or less parallel to and on each side of such lane or way at a greater rate of speed than fifteen miles per hour.
- (2) No person shall, between the hour of eight o'clock in the forenoon and the hour of five o'clock in the afternoon on any day on which school is regularly held, drive or operate a motor vehicle upon a highway at a greater rate of speed than fifteen miles per hour while approaching or passing or in the vicinity of a school where signs relating to such school are displayed stating a speed limit of fifteen miles per hour, or upon which the numerals "15" are prominently shown.
- (3) No person shall drive or operate a motor vehicle upon a highway at a greater rate of speed than fifteen miles per hour when approaching or passing, between dawn and dusk, any public playground for children

where signs are displayed stating a speed limit of fifteen miles per hour or upon which the numerals "15" are prominently shown".
