THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY
BY-LAW NO. 4131

A BY-LAW to provide that the Corporation shall bear a further percentage of the cost of certain local improvement works.

WHEREAS section 596A of the Municipal Act provides that notwithstanding section 595 or 596, where the work is the paving of a street or streets or the construction of curbing or a sidewalk or sidewalks in, upon or along a street or streets, the Council may, by by-law adopted by an affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of all the members thereof, provide that the Corporation shall bear such percentage of the cost of the work as Council may deem proper.

AND WHEREAS the actual cost of constructing the street paving and sidewalks more particularly described in by-laws numbered 3947, 4016, 4061 and 4062 exceeded the estimated cost thereof.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY LOCAL IMPROVEMENT FINANCING BY-LAW NO. 3, 1960."
- 2. Notwithstanding anything contained in by-laws numbered 3947, 4016, 4061 and 4062, the Corporation shall, in addition to its share of the cost of the works described in each of the said by-laws, pay such further percentage of the cost of the said works respectively as the difference between the actual and the estimated cost bears to the actual cost thereof.

Read a first time this 4th day of April, 1960.

Read a second time this 4th day of April, 1960.

Read a third time this 4th day of April, 1960.

Reconsidered and adopted by an affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of all the members of the Council, this llth day of April, 1960.
