

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 4133

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 3047, being the "Burnaby Park Dedication By-Law 1950".

WHEREAS Council adopted By-law No. 3047 on the 22nd day of May, 1950 by a three-fourths vote of all the members thereof, and in clause (d) of section 1 did define and set aside for park purposes those lands more particularly known and described as Lots 26 to 45 inclusive of Block 12 of Lot 29, Group 1, Plan 3035, New Westminster District.

AND WHEREAS no public park or recreation ground has been established on the said lands and no public moneys have been expended thereon.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed advisable and in the public interest to amend By-law No. 3047 and remove the said reservation from Lots 26 to 32 inclusive and from Lots 43 to 45 inclusive of Block 12 of Lot 29, Group 1, Plan 3035, New Westminster District.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY PARK DEDICA-TION BY-LAW 1950, AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1960".

By-law No. 3047 is amended by striking out clause
(d) of section 1 and substituting therefore the following: "(d). Lots 33 to 42 inclusive of Block 12 of Lot 29, Group 1, Plan 3035, New Westminster District".

Read a first time this 19th day of April, 1960. Read a second time this 19th day of April, 1960. Read a third time this 19th day of April, 1960. Received the approval of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council this 5th day of May, 1960.

Reconsidered and adopted by an affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of all the members of the Council this 9th day of May, 1960.
