BY-LAW NO. 4140

A BY-LAW to reserve certain municipally-owned lands for park purposes.

WHEREAS the Council is empowered by section 465 of the "Municipal Act" to reserve for a particular municipal or other public purpose any lands owned by the municipality.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY PARK RESERVATION BY-LAW 1960".

2. The following municipally-owned lands are hereby reserved for purposes of a public park, namely, all and singular those certain parcels or tracts of land and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly known and described as follows:-

(a) Lots 1, 2, 3 and 4 of Lots 1 and 2 of Lot 207, Group 1, Plan 4032, save and except that part of the east half of Lot 3 shown outlined red on plan 15900, New Westminster District; but subject to the rights, liberties and easement of the Greater Vancouver Sewerage and Drainage District in, over and upon Lots 1, 2 and 4 arising out of, under and by virtue of that certain easement or right-of-way dated the 24th day of July, 1956 and registered in the Land Registry Office at New Westminster, British Columbia, as Number 207323C.

(b) Lots 1 and 2 of Lots "A" and "D", Block 1 of Lot 207, Group 1, Plan 13300, except parts shown outlined

red on plan 15900 thereof, New Westminster District.
