BY-LAW NO. 4146

A BY-LAW to amend "Burnaby Club Regulation  
By-law 1950", being By-law No. 3065.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby  
ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY CLUB REGULATION BY-LAW 1950, AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1960".
2. Section 17 of "Burnaby Club Regulation By-law 1950", being By-law No. 3065, is repealed and the following substituted:

"17. All clubs and club premises shall close and remain closed between the hours of two o'clock and seven o'clock in the forenoon each day of the week and on Saturday shall be closed not later than twelve o'clock midnight. Every Manager who suffers or permits the premises of the club of which he is the Manager to remain open contrary to the provisions of this by-law and every member of such club or guest therein who remains on or upon such premises after the hours of closing thereof shall be guilty of an infraction of this by-law and liable to the penalties hereby imposed; provided, however, that the provisions of this section shall not apply to any member who is a bona fide lodger in the premises of a club or to bona fide employees thereof."
