BY-LAW NO. 4165

A BY-LAW to authorize the expropriation of certain real property for highway purposes.

WHEREAS it is deemed desirable and in the public interest to construct a highway from Cliff Avenue to Kitchen-er Street along the route shown outlined in red colour on Plan No. 21697, deposited in the Land Registry Office in the City of New Westminster.

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to expropriate for such purposes the real property hereinafter described,

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY HIGHWAY EXPRO-RIATION BY-LAW 1960".

2. The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered, for highway purposes, and without the consent of the owners of the real property but subject to the provisions of Division (4) of Part XII of the Municipal Act:-

(a) By its servants and agents to enter upon, expropriate, break up, take or enter into possession of or use those portions of Lot 17 and 18 of Lot 135, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 3234, shown outlined in red colour on Plan No. 21697, deposited in the Land Registry Office in the City of New Westminster.

(b) By its servants and agents to enter upon any real property which may be injuriously affected by the construction of the said highway for the purpose of executing any works of construction, maintenance, or repair in mitigation of injuries done or apprehended or in reduction of

compensation.

3. This By-law shall, before coming into effect, be published once in the B. C. Gazette and in a newspaper published or circulating in the Municipality of Burnaby and a certified copy of the by-law shall be filed in the Land Registry Office in the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia.
