## THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

## BY-LAW NO. 4167

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 4035, being "Burnaby Local Improvement Construction By-Law No. 2, 1959".

WHEREAS by By-law No. 4035 Council authorized the construction of a 5 foot Portland cement sidewalk with curb as a local improvement on the initiative plan.

AND WHEREAS the estimated cost of the said work was \$2,974.00.

AND WHEREAS the estimated owners' portion of the cost of the said work was \$2,481.62.

AND WHEREAS the estimated Corporation's portion of the cost of the said work was \$492.38.

AND WHEREAS notwithstanding Section 595 or 596 of the Municipal Act, where the work is paving of a street or streets or the construction of a curb or sidewalk or sidewalks in, upon or along a street or streets, the Council may, by by-law adopted by an affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of all the members thereof, provide that the Corporation shall bear such percentage of the cost of the work as the Council may deem proper.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY LOCAL IMPROVE-MENT CONSTRUCTION BY-LAW NO. 2, 1959, AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1960".
- 2. Notwithstanding anything in By-law No. 4035 contained, The Corporation of the District of Burnaby shall bear, in addition to its statutory portion of the cost of the said

work, that part of the owners' portion of the cost of the said work exceeding \$4.13 per lineal foot of work.

Read a third time this 8th day of August, 1960.
