## THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY BY-LAW NO. 4169

A BY-LAW to acquire certain lands for highway purposes.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW 1960."
- 2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owners thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia and more particularly known and described as The West 250' of the South 33' of the North Half of Lot 1 Block 8 of Lot 131 Group 1 Plan 3052 New Westminster District.
- Upon registration of the said deed in fee simple in the Land Registry Office in the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia, the said lands shall be established as a public highway.
