THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 4181

A BY-LAW to extend the period for payment of certain taxes by a soldier.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY TAX PAYMENT EXTENSION BY-LAW 1960".

2. The period for payment of the taxes imposed for the year 1958 upon all and singular that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly known and described as the South Half of Block 63 of Lot 33 Group 1 Plan 944 New Westminster District which is held by and used as the residence of Maurice Austin Hanna, a soldier within the meaning of Section 411 of the Municipal Act, and Beatrice Augusta Hanna, his wife, is hereby extended to the 30th day of September, 1961.
