BY-LAW NO. 4189

A BY-LAW to authorize the expropriation of certain real property for highway purposes.

WHEREAS it is deemed desirable and in the public interest to widen 11th Avenue within the Municipality of Burnaby.

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to expropriate for such purpose the real property hereinafter described.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY HIGHWAY EXPRO-PRIATION BY-LAW NO. 3, 1960."
- 2. The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered, for highway purposes, and without the consent of the owners of the real property but subject to the provisions of Division (4) of Part XII of the Municipal Act:-
- (a) By its servants and agents to enter upon, expropriate, break up, take or enter into possession of or use that portion of Lot 1 of Lot 4 of the easterly part of Lot 25, Group 1, Plan 8301, New Westminster District, more particularly known and described as follows:

"commencing at the south west corner of Lot 1 plan 8301 thence on a bearing of north 38° 33' west a distance of 36.65 feet; thence on a bearing of north 49° 40' 50" east a distance of 128.55 feet; thence on a bearing of south 38° 33' east a distance of 38.55 feet; thence on a bearing of south 50° 33' 30" west a distance of 128.5 feet more or less to the point of commencement",

shown outlined in red colour on plan prepared by G. C. Emerson, B. C. L. S., certified on the 13th day of October, 1960.

- (b) By its servants and agents to enter upon any real property which may be injuriously affected by the construction of the said highway for the purpose of executing any works of construction, maintenance, or repair in mitigation of injuries done or apprehended or in reduction of compensation.
- 3. This By-law shall before coming into effect, be published once in the B. C. Gazette and in a newspaper published or circulating in the Municipality of Burnaby and a certified copy of the by-law shall be filed in the Land Registry Office in the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia.
