THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 4194

A BY-LAW to authorize the construction of certain local improvement works on the initiative plan.

WHEREAS notice of intention of the Council to undertake the construction, as a local improvement, of the works hereinafter described has been duly given by publication of the notice and by service of it upon the owners of the parcels liable to be specially charged.

AND WHEREAS the Clerk has filed a statutory declaration proving publication and service of the said notice.

AND WHEREAS no petition against the said works signed by a majority of the owners, representing at least one-half of the land value of the parcels liable to be specially charged, has been presented.

AND WHEREAS Council has had prepared the report required by Section 600 of the Municipal Act.

AND WHEREAS the lifetime of the said works is twenty years.

AND WHEREAS the estimated cost of the said works is \$81,153.76.

AND WHEREAS the share or proportion of the cost of the said works which should be borne by the parcels of land which abut or which are deemed to abut upon the said works is \$70,900.96.

AND WHEREAS The Corporation's share or proportion of the cost of the said works is \$10.252.80.

AND WHEREAS the special charges should be made payable in fifteen annual instalments.

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NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY LOCAL IMPROVE-MENT CONSTRUCTION BY-LAW NO. 14, 1960".

2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to construct as local improvements under the provisions of Part XVI of the Municipal Act Portland cement concrete sidewalks five feet wide with curbs and local drainage works therefore and also asphaltic pavement eight feet to eleven feet wide for purposes of road widening, on the following streets:

- (a) Both sides of Balmoral Street from Sperling Avenue to Colbourne Avenue.
- (b) North East side of Linden Street from Edmonds Street to Elwell Street.
- (c) Both sides of Cumberland Street from Tenth Avenue to Thirteenth Avenue.
- (d) South side of Rumble Street from Royal Oak Avenue to McGregor Avenue.
- (e) West side of Royal Oak Avenue from Rumble Street to Clinton Street.
- (f) Northeast side of Sixth Street from Tenth Avenue to Edmonds Street.
- (g) Northwest side of Tenth Avenue from Cumberland Street to Coquitlam Street.

3. The Reeve and Clerk are authorized and empowered to cause a contract for the construction of the said works to be made and entered into with some person or persons, firm or corporation, subject to the approval of this Council to be declared by resolution.

4. The special charges shall be paid by fifteen annual instalments.

5.(1) Where the number of feet of a parcel of land which abuts on any of the said works is more than 66 feet, the taxable foot frontage shall be 66 feet.

(2) Notwithstanding anything in this by-law contained (a) where a parcel of land is situated at the junction or intersection of streets and the work is provided on or along more than one side of the parcel, the taxable foot frontage shall be not more than 66 feet; (b) where a parcel of land is situate at the junction or intersection of streets and the work is provided on or along a second side of the parcel, where a similar work is already provided on or along one side, the taxable foot frontage shall be not more than 66 feet less the taxable foot frontage already charged against the parcel for the similar work; and (c) where the front and rear boundaries of a parcel of land each abut on a highway, other than a lane, and the work is provided on or along both such boundaries, the taxable foot frontage shall be not more than 66 feet.

(3) For the purposes of this section, lane is defined as a right of way 20 feet or less in width separating the rear property lines of parcels of land fronting on highways running more or less parallel to and on each side of such rights of way.

(4) The provisions of subsection (1) shall not apply to the following parcels of land and the actual foot frontage thereof shall be the taxable foot frontage:

Lots 23, 24 and 25 Block 1 of Lot 30 Group 1 Plan 3036 New Westminster District.

The North Half of Lot "A" of Blocks 2 and 3 of Lot 25 Group 1 Plan 12370 New Westminster District.

The South Half of Lot "A" of Blocks 2 and 3 of Lot 25 Group 1 Plan 12370 New Westminster District.

Lot "B" Block 2 of the North West Quarter of the North Half of the South West Quarter of Lot 158 Group 1 Plan **3**423 New Westminster District.

Lot "A" Block 2 of the North West Quarter of the North Half of the South West Quarter of Lot 158 Group 1 Plan 3423 New Westminster District.

Lots 32, 33 and 34 Block 4 of Lot 28 Group 1 Plan 274 New Westminster District.

Lot "C" Block 6 of Lot 28 Group 1 Plan 8401 New Westminster District. Lot "A" Block 16 of Lot 28 Group 1 Plan 5406 New Westminster District.

Lots 42,43, 44 and 45 Block "A" of Lot 28 Group 1 Plan 10459 New Westminster District. Lots 16 and 17 Block "A" of Lot 28 Group 1 Plan



6. The Assessor shall forthwith prepare a frontagetax assessment roll in respect of the said works pursuant to section 416 of the Municipal Act and shall from time to time revise the said frontage-tax assessment roll in accordance with subsection (3) of the said section 416.

7. The Council may, with the approval of the Inspector of Municipalities, borrow temporarily the sum required to finance the cost of the said works pending the adoption of a by-law under section 603 of the Municipal Act.

(1) Both sides of Thirteenth Avenue from Newcombe Street to Wright Street

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- (2) Both sides of Barnet Road from Inlet Drive to Ridge Drive
- (3) South side of Ridge Drive from the east property line of Lot 107 to the east property line of Lot 104
- (4) West side of Alpha Avenue from Hastings Street to Union Street

- 2. The total cost of constructing the said works is \$56,697.30; the Corporation's share is \$8,387.67; and the owners' share is \$48,309.63.

- 4. The total actual foot-frontage is 7,850.12 feet, the total taxable foot-frontage is 6,974.88 feet, and the sum required to be raised annually during the period of fifteen years is \$4,874.14.

SCHEDULE "I" BY-LAW NO. 4194

- 1. Pursuant to By-law No. 4194, adopted on the 14th day of November 1960, Portland cement concrete sidewalks five feet wide with curbs and local drainage works therefore and also asphaltic pavement eight feet to eleven feet wide for purposes of road widening, have been constructed on the streets hereinafter described:-
 - (1) Both sides of Balmoral Street from Sperling Avenue to Colbourne Avenue
 - (2) North east side of Linden Street from Edmonds Street to Elwell Street
 - (3) Both sides of Cumberland Street from Tenth Avenue to Thirteenth Avenue
 - (4) South side of Rumble Street from Royal Oak Avenue to McGregor Avenue
 - (5) West side of Royal Oak Avenue from Rumble Street to Clinton Street
 - (6) North east side of Sixth Street from Tenth Avenue to Edmonds Street
 - (7) North west side of Tenth Avenue from Cumberland Street to Coquitlam Street.
- 2. The total cost of constructing the said works is \$94,562.87; the Corporation's share is \$17,036.87; and the owners' share is \$77,526.00.
- 3. The estimated lifetime of the said works is twenty years.
- 4. The total actual foot-frontage is 10,260.19 feet, the total taxable foot-frontage is 6,351.56 feet, and the sum required to be raised annually during the period of fifteen years is \$7,822.37.

SCHEDULE "J" BY-LAW NO. 4269

- 1. Pursuant to By-law No. 4269, adopted on the 7th day of August 1961, concrete sidewalks four feet wide have been constructed on the streets hereinafter described:-
