

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 4197

A BY-LAW to stop up and close to traffic a portion of highway within the municipality.

WHEREAS the lands hereinafter described were established as a public highway by "Burnaby Road Acquisition and Dedication By-law No.1, 1959" being By-law No. 4021, and which was filed in the Land Registry Office at New Westminster on the 16th day of April, 1959, under No. 48558.

AND WHEREAS the said lands have not been constructed nor opened to traffic and are no longer required for highway purposes.

NOW THEREFORE The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD CLOSING BY-LAW NO. 8, 1960".
2. That certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly known and described as part of Lot 7 Block 9 of Lot 159 Group 1 Plan 2103 as shown outlined red on plan with by-law filed No. 48558 New Westminster District, is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.

Read a first time this 21st day of November, 1960.

Read a second time this 21st day of November, 1960.

Read a third time this 21st day of November, 1960.

Reconsidered and adopted this 28th day of November, 1960.
