

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 4201

VF 1974

A BY-LAW to exempt from taxation certain lands within the Municipality.

WHEREAS the property described in Schedule "A" hereto but for a secondary use thereof and thereon would in the opinion of the Council be in conformity with the conditions necessary to qualify for tax exemption pursuant to clause (g) of subsection (1) of section 325 of the Municipal Act.

AND WHEREAS, such secondary use consists of the provision of living quarters in part of the building situate upon the said property.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY TAXATION EXEMPTION BY-LAW NO. 4, 1960".
2. That for the year 1961 the proportions of the lands described in Schedule "A" and all the improvements thereon which shall be taxable and exempt respectively are as follows:

	<u>TAXABLE</u>	<u>EXEMPT</u>
Land	0%	100%
Improvements	38%	62%

Read a first time this 21st day of November, 1960.

Read a second time this 21st day of November, 1960.

Read a third time this 21st day of November, 1960.

Reconsidered and adopted by an affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of all the members of the Council this 28th day of November, 1960.
