## BY-LAW NO. 4202

## A BY-LAW to acquire certain lands for highway purposes and to establish certain other lands owned by the Municipality as a public highway.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISI-TION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 3, 1960".

2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owners thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, in consideration of the sum of Seven Hundred Dollars those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and more particularly known and described as the North 10 feet of Lot 3 of Block 74 of Lot 123 and Part of Lots 122 and 124, Group 1, Plan 1543, New Westminster District.

3. Upon registration of the said deed in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia, the said lands shall be established as a public highway.

4. Those municipally-owned lands situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and more particularly described as the North 10 feet of:

(a) Lot 10 of Block 74 of Lot 123 and Part of

Lots 122 and 124, Group 1, Plan 1543, New Westminster District.

(b) Lots 3 and 13 of Block 75 of Lot 123 and Part of Lots 122 and 124, Group 1, Plan 1543, New Westminster District.

are hereby established as a public highway.
