BY-LAW NO. 4222

A BY-LAW to authorize the Corporation to bear an additional share of the cost of certain local improvement works pursuant to Section 597 of the Municipal Act.

WHEREAS Council may, where the work is the paving of a street or streets or construction of curbing or a sidewalk of sidewalks in, upon, or along a street or streets, by by-law adopted by an affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of all the members thereof, provide that the Corporation shall bear such percentage of the cost of the work as Council may deem proper.

AND WHEREAS By-law No. 4077, adopted on the 2nd day of November, 1959, authorized the construction of sidewalks upon the streets therein described.

AND WHEREAS By-law No. 4094, adopted on the 7th day of December, 1959, authorized the construction of sidewalks and curbing upon the streets therein described.

AND WHEREAS By-law No. 4183, adopted on the 3rd day of October, 1960, authorized the paving of the street therein described.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY LOCAL IMPROVE-MENT COST SHARING BY-LAW 1961."
- 2. Notwithstanding anything contained in Sections 595 or 596 of the Municipal Act or in By-Law No. 4077, the Corporation shall bear that portion of the cost of the local improvement works described in By-Law No. 4077 which exceeds \$3.20 per taxable front foot.
- 3. Notwithstanding anything contained in Sections 595 or 596 of the Municipal Act or in By-Law No. 4094, the Corpora-

tion shall bear that portion of the cost of the local improvement works described in By-Law No. 4094 which exceeds \$4.30 per taxable front foot.

4. Notwithstanding anything contained in Sections 595 or 596 of the Municipal Act or in By-Law No. 4183, the Corporation shall bear that portion of the cost of the local improvement works described in By-Law No. 4183 which exceeds \$2.85 per taxable front foot.
