## BY-LAW NO. 4244

A BY-LAW to acquire certain lands for highway purposes.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW No.2, 1961".
- 2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owners thereof by good and sufficient deed or deeds in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia and more particularly known and described as the North Ten feet of Lots 24, 25 and 26 of Blocks 24 and 25 of Lot 159 Group 1 Plan 1268 New Westminster District.
- 3. Upon registration of the said deed or deeds in fee simple in the Land Registry Office in the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia, the said lands shall be established as a public highway.
