## THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY BY-LAW NO. 4283

A BY-LAW to extend the period for payment of certain taxes by the widow of a deceased soldier.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY TAX PAYMENT EXTENSION BY-LAW 1961".
- 2. The period for payment of the taxes imposed for the year 1959 upon all and singular that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly known and described as Lot 108 of part of Block 2 of Lot 216, Group 1, Plan 11656, New Westminster District which is held by and used as the residence of Anne May Duller, the widow of Bernard George Duller, a soldier within the meaning of Section 411 of the Municipal Act, is hereby extended to the 30th day of September, 1961.
