BY-LAW NO.4343

A BY-LAW to amend By-law No. 3102, being the "Burnaby Cab and Commercial Vehicles By-law 1951".

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY CAB AND COMMERCIAL VEHICLES BY-LAW 1951, AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1962".
- 2. By-law No. 3102 is amended by adding the following as Section 11A:
- "llA(1). Every ambulance conveying a sick or injured person shall have a crew of not less than two persons including both a driver and an ambulance attendant.
 - (2). Every ambulance attendant shall hold at least a valid and subsisting Class "C" Certificate of Competency in Industrial First Aid issued or approved by the Workmen's Compensation Board of the Province of British Columbia.
 - (3). Every ambulance attendant shall keep a record in duplicate of all first aid emergency or other treatment administered to a patient transported to a hospital in his ambulance and shall deliver one copy thereof to the admitting hospital and retain the other copy at the office of his employer for a period of one year."
