BY-LAW NO. 4343

A BY-LAW to amend By-law No. 3102, being the "Burnaby Cab and Commercial Vehicles By-law 1951".

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY CAB AND COMMERCIAL VEHICLES BY-LAW 1951, AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1962".
2. By-law No. 3102 is amended by adding the following as Section 11A:

"11A(1). Every ambulance conveying a sick or injured person shall have a crew of not less than two persons including both a driver and an ambulance attendant.

(2). Every ambulance attendant shall hold at least a valid and subsisting Class "C" Certificate of Competency in Industrial First Aid issued or approved by the Workmen's Compensation Board of the Province of British Columbia.

(3). Every ambulance attendant shall keep a record in duplicate of all first aid emergency or other treatment administered to a patient transported to a hospital in his ambulance and shall deliver one copy thereof to the admitting hospital and retain the other copy at the office of his employer for a period of one year."
