BY-LAW NO. 4372

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 3658, being the
"Burnaby Waterworks Loan By-Law 1955."

WHEREAS By-Law No. 3658, being the "Burnaby Waterworks Loan By-Law 1955", authorized the construction of the certain waterworks defined therein and the borrowing of \$825,000.00 therefor by the issue and sale of debentures.

AND WHEREAS all of the said waterworks have been constructed save and except the 10" water main, 360 feet long, on Sperling Avenue between Grandview-Douglas Highway and Claude Street and the costs thereof have been fully paid.

AND WHEREAS the balance remaining unexpended of the moneys so borrowed amounts to \$19,344.34.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY WATERWORKS LOAN BY-LAW 1955, AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1962."

2. Schedule "A" of By-Law No. 3658 is amended by striking out the following:

<u>"STREET</u>	<u>FROM</u>	<u>TO</u>	<u>DISTANCE</u>	<u>SIZE</u>
SPERLING AVENUE	GRANDVIEW-DOUGLAS	CLAUDE STREET	360	10" "

3. The Council is hereby authorized and empowered to expend the sum of \$19,344.34, being the unexpended balance of the moneys borrowed pursuant to By-Law No. 3658, for the construction of the following waterworks:

(a) An 8" main on Sprott Street from Sperling west a distance of approximately 330 feet

(b) A 12" main on Sperling Avenue north from Sprott Street a distance of approximately 1,000 feet.

4. This By-law shall, before the final adoption thereof, receive the approval of the Inspector of Municipalities and the approval of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council.

Received the approval of the Inspector of Municipalities this 26th day of June, 1962.

Received the approval of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council this 6th day of July, 1962.
