BY-LAW NO. 4376

A BY-LAW to acquire certain lands for highway purposes.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 7, 1962".

2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owner thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable consideration those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly known and described as that portion of Lot 7 of Lot 35, Block 49, of Lots 151, 152 and 153, Group 1, District of New Westminster, Plan 4522, more particularly described as follows:

"Commencing at the most Easterly corner of Lot 7, aforesaid;

Thence N.55°00'30"W., and following the North-easterly boundary of the said Lot 7, a distance of 20.00 feet to a point;

Thence S.17°33'00"W., a distance of 12.00 feet, more or less, to an intersection with the Southerly boundary of said Lot 7;

Thence S.89°55'00"E., and following the Southerly boundary of said Lot 7, a distance of 20.00 feet to the point of commencement, and containing by admeasurement 114.5 square feet, be the same more or less, as shown outlined in Red colour on the plan hereunto annexed."

3. Upon registration of the said deed in fee simple in the Land Registry Office in the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia, the said lands shall be established as a public highway.
