THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 4380

A BY-LAW to acquire certain lands for highway purposes.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 9, 1962".
2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owners thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, for the considerations hereinafter appearing, those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly known and described as:

- (a) The North 4' of Lot 31, Block 26 of Lot 159, Group 1, Plan 5522, New Westminster District, *(Lennon)* in consideration of the sum of One Dollar.
- (b) The North 4' of Lot 32, Block 26 of Lot 159, Group 1, Plan 5522, New Westminster District, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar.
- (c) The North 4' of Lot 33, Block 26 of Lot 159, Group 1, Plan 5522, New Westminster District, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar.
- (d) The North 4' of Lot 34, Block 26 of Lot 159, Group 1, Plan 5522, New Westminster District, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar.
- (e) The North 10' of Lot 2 of Lot 156, Group 1, Plan 14380, New Westminster District, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar.
- (f) The North 10' of Lot 1 of Lot 156, Group 1, Plan 14380, New Westminster District, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar.

3. Upon registration of the said deeds in fee simple in the Land Registry Office in the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia, the said lands shall be established as a public highway.
