BY-LAW NO.4397

A BY-LAW to acquire certain lands for highway purposes.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 11, 1962".
2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owner thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable consideration, those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly known and described as that portion of Block "M" of Lot 2 of Block 5 of Lot 206, Group 1, Plan 3402, Save and Except part 0.49 of an acre as shown on Sketch No.5733, New Westminster District, shown outlined in red on right-of-way plan No.21763.
3. Upon registration of the said deed in fee simple in the Land Registry Office in the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia, the said lands shall be established as a public highway.
