

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 4415

A BY-LAW to acquire certain lands for high-way purposes.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 13, 1962".

2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owner thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for high-way purposes, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable consideration, those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly known and described as part of that portion of Lots 2 and 3 shown lettered "F" lying and being in Lot 2, Block 5 of Lot 206, Group 1, Plan 2165, shown coloured on Sketch 4846, New Westminster District, which said part is more particularly known and described as follows:

The 0.002 acre portion of Parcel "F", Reference Plan 4846, of Lot 2, Block 5 of Lot 206, Group 1, Plan 2165, shown outlined in Red on Plan No. 21763.

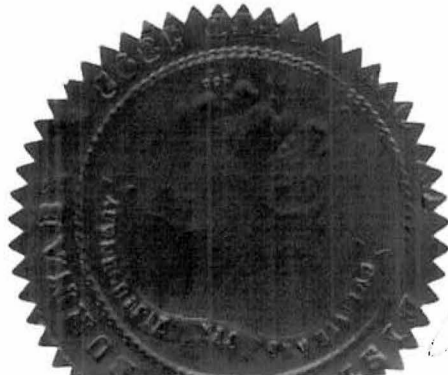
3. Upon registration of the said deed in fee simple in the Land Registry Office in the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia, the said lands shall be established as a public highway.
