A BY-LAW to acquire certain lands for highway purposes.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 2, 1963".
2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owners thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable consideration, those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly known and described as those portions of Lots 1 to 4, both inclusive, Block 1 of the East Half of Lot 119, Plan 2855, New Westminster District, and Lot "A", Block 2 of the West Half of Lot 119, Plan 11285, Group 1, New Westminster District, shown outlined in Red on plan prepared by J. E. Hermon, B.C.L.S., dated the 21st day of December 1962, hereunto annexed.
3. Upon registration of the said deed in fee simple in the Land Registry Office in the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia, the said lands shall be established as a public highway.
