BY-LAW NO. 4477<br>A BY-LAW to acquire certain lands for highway purposes.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATICN BY-LAW NO. 8, 1963".
2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owners thereof by a good and sufficient deed in feestmple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, in consideration of the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Nunicipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly known and described as that portion of the West Half of Lot Nine (9), Block Nine (9) of the South Half of Lot One Hundred and Sixteen (116), Group One, New Westminster District according to the plan deposited in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia, and numbered One thousand four hundred and thirty-nine (1439) which said portion may be more particularly described as follows:
"Comencing at the northwest corner of the West Half of said Lot Nine (9), Plan 1439; thence South eighty-nine degrees seven minutes and fifteen seconds east (S.89007'15胃) along the northerly boundary of said lot, ten (l0) feet; thence South forty-five degrees twenty-six minutes and thirty seconds west ( $\$ 45^{\circ} 26^{\prime} 30^{\prime \prime}$ W) fourteen and three hundredths (14.03) feet, more or less, to a point on the westerly boundary of said West Half of Lot 9 which said point is situate distant ten (10) feet measured southerly from the aforesaid north-west corner; thence North zero degree zero qinute and twenty seconds east ( $\mathrm{N} .0000^{\prime} 20^{\mathrm{HE}}$ ) along the said westerly boundary, ten (10) feet to the point of commencement; all the said bearings are Astronomic and are referred to the meridian of Plan Twenty-one thousand two hundred and forty (21240) deposited; the said portion containing Fifty (50) square feet, more or less, as shown outlined in red on the plan attached hereto."
3. Upon registration of the sa1d deed in fee simple in the Land Registry Office in the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia, the said lands shall be established as a public highway.
