THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 4520

A BY-LAW to authorize the expropriation of certain real property.

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and in the public interest to expropriate the real property hereinafter described for highway purposes and to construct and install thereon necessary municipal works and services.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of The District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-Law may be cited as "BURNABY HIGHWAY EXPRO-PRIATION BY-LAW NO. 1, 1964".
- 2. For highway purposes and for the construction and installation thereon of necessary municipal works and services The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered, without the consent of the owners of the real property but subject to the provisions of Division (4) of Part XII of the Municipal Act:-
- (a) By its servants and agents to enter upon, expropriate, break up, take or enter into possession of or use all and singular that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly known and described as the West Half of Lot Two (2), Block Eleven (11), of Lot One Hundred and Sixteen (116), Group One (1), Plan 1236, New Westminster District.
- (b) By its servants and agents to enter upon any real property which may be injuriously affected by the exercise of any of the aforesaid powers for the purpose of executing any works

construction, maintenance, or repair in mitigation of apprehended or in reduction of compensation. done or ч.. О
