THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 4532

A BY-LAW to regulate and prohibit the sale and setting off of fire crackers and fire-

The Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY FIREWORKS l. REGULATION BY-LAW, 1964".
- In this By-law, "fireworks" means non-explosive 2. fireworks and "firecrackers" means explosive type fireworks.
- 3. Except as hereinafter provided, no person shall sell, offer or expose for sale, advertise or display any firecrackers, or use, set off, or discharge any firecrackers within the Municipality.
- 4. Except from and including the 25th day of October to and including the 31st day of/October, no person shall sell, offer or expose for sale, advertise or display any fireworks, or use or set off any fireworks within the Municipality.
- 5. No person shall use, set off or discharge any fireworks or firecrackers in any street, lane, square or public place at any time.
- 6. Notwithstanding the provisions of this By-law, fireworks and firecrackers may at any time be sold to and set off or discharged by any person or organization conducting a public display, if such public display is held with the written permission of the Fire Marshall.
- 7. No vendor of fireworks or firecrackers shall sell fireworks or firecrackers without instructions in writing given to the purchaser for the safe use, setting off or discharge of the same.

- 8. Every vendor of fireworks shall during the period from and including the 25th day of October to and including the 31st day of October prominently display a copy of this By-law within his premises.
- 9. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this By-law shall be guilty of an offence upon summary conviction and shall be liable to a fine not exceeding \$200.00 and in default of payment to imprisonment not exceeding three months.
