THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY BY-LAW NO. 4566

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 1991, being the "Burnaby Town Planning By-Law 1948"

WHEREAS it is deemed desirable and expedient to amend "Burnaby Town Planning By-Law 1948" as hereinafter set forth.

AND WHEREAS Council has held a public hearing thereon after duly giving notice of the time and place of such hearing.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-Law may be cited as "BURNABY TOWN PLANNING BY-LAW 1948, AMENDMENT BY-LAW NO. 8, 1964".
- 2. Section 10-B of By-Law No. 1991 is repealed and the following substituted therefore:
 - "10-B (1) Use of land or buildings is restricted to such uses as are permitted in a Commercial Zone except as hereinafter may be expressly forbidden.
 - (2) In a Local Commercial Zone the following uses of land or buildings are expressly forbidden:
 - (a) Public Garage
 - (b) Service or gas station
 - (c) Storage warehouse
 - (d) Auto Court
 - (e) Funeral or undertaking establishment, morgue, mortuary or crematorium
 - (f) Any use permitted by clauses (d) and (e) of Section 10.

(3) In a Local Commercial Zone the same set backs, building lines and side yards required in a Residential Single Family Zone shall apply."

Read a first time this 17th day of February, 1964.

Read a second time this 17th day of February, 1964.

Read a third time this 16th day of March, 1964.

Reconsidered and adopted by a two-thirds vote of all the members of Council this 23rd day of March, 1964.
