

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 4673

A BY-LAW to amend By-law No. 3970, being the "Burnaby Shops Closing By-Law 1958".

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY SHOPS CLOSING BY-LAW 1958, AMENDMENT BY-LAW NO. 2, 1964".

2. Section 2 of By-law No. 3970 is amended

(a) by adding the following definition of "Bookstore":

" 'Bookstore' means a shop devoted exclusively to the sale of books and periodicals", and

(b) by striking out the definition of "Shop" and substituting the following:

" 'Shop' shall have the same meaning as set out in Section 857 of the Municipal Act".

3. Section 3 is repealed and the following substituted:

"3. For the local convenience and well-being of the residents of the Municipality the Council does hereby exempt completely from the provisions of Sections 858 and 859 of the Municipal Act the classes of shops more particularly defined in Section 2."

4. Section 4 is repealed and the following substituted:

"4. In each week of the year, all shops as defined in Section 857 of the Municipal Act shall be closed for the serving of customers:

(a) on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Saturday of each week not later than six o'clock in the afternoon, and

(b) on Thursday and Friday not later than nine o'clock in the afternoon;

and shall remain closed thereafter for the remainder of each such day."

5. Section 5 is repealed and the following substituted:

"5. Notwithstanding anything in this by-law contained, barber shops shall be closed and remain closed for the serving of customers:

(a) on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday not later than six o'clock in the afternoon.

(b) on Monday for the entirety of the said day, provided that when a holiday as defined in Section 858 of the Municipal Act occurs in any week and does not fall on Monday, barber shops may remain open on Monday in that week until the hour of six o'clock in the afternoon".

6. By-law No. 3970 is further amended by adding the following as Section 5A:

"5A. Notwithstanding anything in this by-law contained, hairdressing shops shall be closed and remain closed for the serving of customers:

(a) on Tuesday, Wednesday and Saturday not later than six o'clock in the afternoon.

(b) On Thursday and Friday not later than nine o'clock in the afternoon.

(c) on Monday for the entirety of the said day, provided that when a holiday as defined in section 858 of the Municipal Act occurs in any week and does not fall on Monday, hairdressing shops may remain open on Monday in that week not later than six o'clock in the afternoon".

7. Section 6 is repealed and the following substituted:

"6. Notwithstanding anything in this by-law contained all shops may remain open for the serving of customers until the hour of nine o'clock in the afternoon on any or all of the seven business days immediately preceding Christmas day, and on any day immediately preceding a holiday as defined in Section

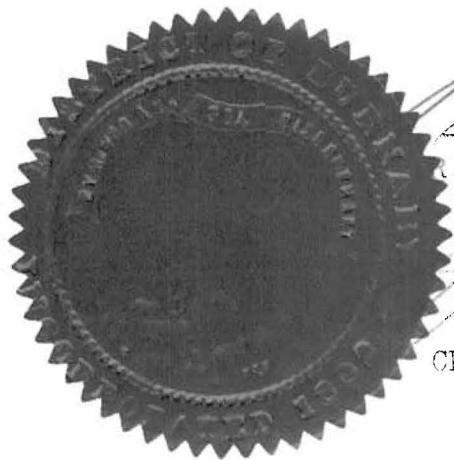
858 of the Municipal Act when such holiday falls on a Friday".
