A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 1914, being the "Burnaby Automatic Vending Machine By-Law 1946".

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY AUTOMATIC VENDING MACHINE BY-LAW 1946, AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1964".
- 2. Subsection (2) of section 8 of By-Law No. 1914, as enacted by By-Law No. 4234, is repealed and the following substituted therefor:
- "(2) All licenses issued shall be for a period of six months or less terminating on the 30th day of April and on the 31st day of October, and no proportionate reduction shall be made on account of any person commencing or ceasing to do business at any particular time. Provided that the first license period which commences in 1965 shall run from the 15th day of January to the 31st day of October, and the fee for such license period shall be proportional to the fee prescribed for a six-month period for any class of automatic vending machine."
