BY-LAW NO. 4683

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 1481, being the "Burnaby Cabaret Regulation By-Law 1934".

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

 This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY CABARET REGULATION BY-LAW 1934, AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1964".

2. Section 9 of By-Law No. 1481 is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"9. The license fee for such Cabaret shall be according to the seating capacity thereof, and shall be paid for on the following scale:

Seating accommodation up to and including 50 seats per annum.	- \$ 20.00
Seating accommodation of 51 and up to 100 seats per annum.	- \$ 100.00
Seating accommodation of 101 up to 150 seats per annum.	- \$ 150. 00
Seating accommodation of 151 seats or over per annum.	- \$ 200.00

The license fee herein shall be payable in advance for each and every six months on the 30th day of April and on the 31st day of October in each and every year, and no proportionate reduction shall be made on account of any person commencing or ceasing to do business at any particular time. Provided that the first license period which commences in 1965 shall run from the 15th day of

January to the 31st day of October, and the fee for such license period shall be proportional to the license fee prescribed for a six-month period."
