

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 4716

A BY-LAW to acquire certain lands for highway purposes.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

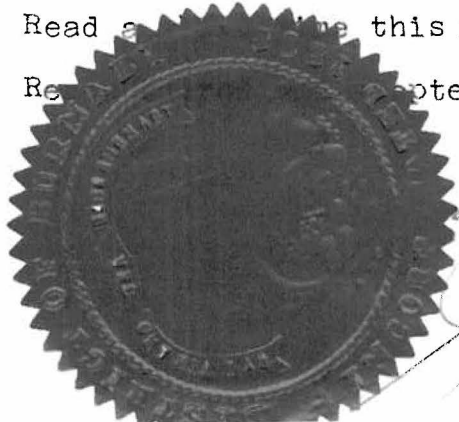
1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 6, 1965".
2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owners thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other good and valuable consideration, those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly known and described as those portions of Block "V" of Lots Two Hundred and Five (205), Two Hundred and Six (206), Two Hundred and Seventeen (217), and Two Hundred and Eighteen (218), Group One, Plan \_\_\_\_\_, New Westminster District, shown outlined in red on the plan attached hereto, prepared by James Davidson, B.C.L.S., dated the 25th day of September, 1964.
3. Upon registration of the said deed in fee simple in the Land Registry Office in the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia, the said lands shall be established as a public highway.

Read a third time this 22 day of March, 1965.
