

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 4736

A BY-LAW to acquire certain lands for highway purposes.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 12, 1965".

2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owners thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other good and valuable consideration, those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly known and described as:

- (a) The 0.068 acre portion of the North Half of Block 6 of Lot 82, Group 1, Plan 11987, New Westminster District.
- (b) The 0.228 acre portion of Lot 81, Group 1, Plan 3062, New Westminster District.
- (c) The 2.544 acre portion of Lot 72, Group 1, Plan 3059, New Westminster District, except part subdivided by Plan 15514.

all as shown outlined in red on plan hereto annexed prepared by C. P. Aplin, B.C.L.S., dated the 17th day of April, 1964.

3. Upon registration of the said deeds in fee simple in the Land Registry Office in the City of New Westminster,

in the Province of British Columbia, the said lands shall be established as a public highway.
