

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 4765

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 4742, being
the "Burnaby Zoning By-Law 1965".

WHEREAS it is deemed desirable and expedient to
amend "Burnaby Zoning By-Law 1965" as hereinafter set forth.

AND WHEREAS Council has held a public hearing thereon
after duly giving notice of the time and place of such hearing.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the
District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ZONING BY-LAW
1965, AMENDMENT BY-LAW NO. 2, 1965".
2. Section 3 of By-Law No. 4742 is amended by striking
out the definition of Home Occupation and substituting the follow-
ing:

"HOME OCCUPATION means an occupation or profession which is clearly
incidental to the use of a dwelling unit for residential purposes,
or to the residential use of a lot occupied by a dwelling, and
includes:

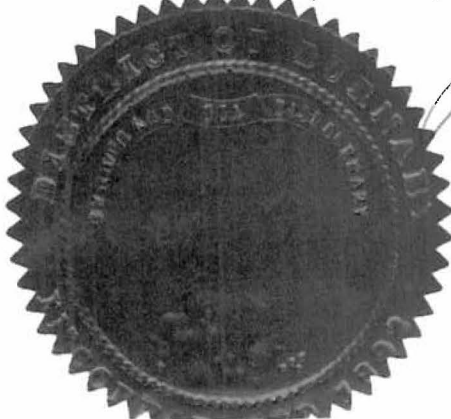
- (1) the office of an accountant, architect, clergyman, dentist,
engineer, lawyer, physician or other professional person;
- (2) the office or studio of an artist, chiropractor, dressmaker,
music teacher, musician, seamstress, writer, or of persons
engaged in home crafts or hobbies;
- (3) the keeping of not more than 2 boarders or lodgers or not
more than 4 foster children in each dwelling unit; and
- (4) the operation of a kindergarten or day nursery for not
more than 5 children."

Read a first time this 13th day of September, 1965.

Read a second time this 13th day of September, 1965.

Read a third time this 13th day of September, 1965.

Reconsidered and adopted by a two-thirds vote of all the
members of Council this 20th day of September, 1965.
