## THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 4797

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A BY-LAW to authorize the expropriation of certain real property.

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary amin the public interest to expropriate the real property hereinafter described for highway purposes and to construct and install thereon necessary municipal works and services.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY HIGHWAY EXPROPRIATION BY-LAW NO. 3, 1965".
- 2. For highway purposes and for the construction and installation thereon of necessary municipal works and services The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered, without the consent of the owners of the real property but subject to the provisions of Division (4) of Part XII of the Municipal Act:-
- (a) By its servants and agents to enter upon, expropriate, break up, take or enter into possession of or use all and singular those certain parcels or tracts of land and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly described as follows:
  - (1) The 0.429 acre portion of Lot One (1), of Block Six (6) of Lot Seventy-eight (78), Group 1, Plan 11087, New Westminster District, shown outlined in red on plan filed in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, Province aforesaid, and numbered A-54179;
  - (2) The 0.206 acre portion of Lot Two (2) of Block Six (6) of Lot Seventy-eight (78), Group 1, Plan 11087, New West-minster District, shown outlined in red on plan filed in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, Province aforesaid, and numbered A-54179;

- (3) The 0.006 acre portion of Lot Three
  (3) of Block Six (6) of Lot Seventyeight (78), Group 1, Plan 11087, New
  Westminster District, shown outlined
  in red on plan filed in the Land Registry
  Office at the City of New Westminster,
  Province of British Columbia, and numbered
  A-54179;
- (4) The 1.363 acre portion of Lot Six (6) of Block Six (6), of Lot Seventy-eight (78) Group 1, Plan 11087, New Westminster District, shown outlined in red on plantified in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, Province aforesaid, and numbered A-54179;
- (b) By its servants and agents to enter upon any real property which may be injuriously affected by the exercise of any of the aforesaid powers for the purpose of executing any works of construction, maintenance or repair in mitigation of injuries done or apprehended or in reduction of compensation.
- 3. This By-law shall, before coming into effect, be published once in the B. C. Gazette and in a newspaper published or circulating in the Municipality of Burnaby and a certified copy of the by-law shall be filed in the Land Registry Office in the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia.
