

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 4850

A BY-LAW to exempt from taxation certain lands and premises within the Municipality pursuant to Section 328 of the Municipal Act.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY TAXATION EXEMPTION BY-LAW NO. 10, 1965",
2. The following lands, and the improvements thereon, are hereby exempt from taxation imposed under clauses (a), (b) and (c) of subsection (1) of Section 206 of the Municipal Act for the year 1966, namely:

Those lands occupied and held by the Young Men's Christian Association of Burnaby and being described as that portion of Lot 2, Block 17 of the North part of Lot 79, Group 1, Plan 1386, New Westminster District, shown outlined in Green colour on the sketch annexed to By-law 4411 and the improvements thereon.
