

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 4857

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 3089, being the  
"Burnaby Trades License By-Law 1950".

The Council of The Corporation of the District of  
Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY TRADES LICENSE  
BY-LAW 1950, AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1965".

2. Section 1 of By-Law No. 3089 is amended by adding the  
following:

"Agent" - means a person who, on his own behalf or on behalf of  
another, within the Municipality, sells, solicits,  
offers for sale or takes orders for the sale of goods,  
wares, merchandise, foodstuff, article, or thing to be  
afterwards delivered to the customer, or solicits or  
takes orders for services to be afterwards performed  
on the premises of the customer.

"Canvasser" - means a person who, on his own behalf or on behalf  
of another, within the Municipality, solicits or takes  
orders for works or services to be performed elsewhere  
than on the premises of the customer.

"Hawker, Peddler, Huckster" - means a person who, within the  
Municipality, sells or offers for sale goods, wares,  
merchandise, foodstuff, article or thing to be  
immediately delivered to the customer.

"Municipality" - means The Corporation of the District of Burnaby.

"Room" - means a room or any space being used as a room, but  
shall not include a bathroom. A combined living and  
dining room shall be deemed to be two rooms. A  
combined living room and kitchen shall be deemed to be  
two rooms."

3. Section 9 of By-Law No. 3089 as amended is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"9. Beginning on the 1st day of January, 1966, and except in the case of a daily, monthly, or three months license, all licenses granted under this By-law, unless the same become sooner forfeited, shall be for the calendar year current at the time of issuing thereof, and shall expire on the 31st day of December next succeeding the date of issue of same; and no proportionate reduction of license fee shall be made on account of any person commencing or ceasing business after the beginning of the year, except that a person who becomes liable to be licensed after the 31st day of July in any year, shall pay one-half the prescribed license fee."

4. Schedule "A" of By-Law No. 3089 as amended is repealed and the following substituted therefor:
