THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY BY-LAW NO. 4867

A BY-LAW to amend By-law No. 1914 being the "Burnaby Automatic Vending Machine > By-law 1946.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY AUTOMATIC VENDING MACHINE BY-LAW 1946, AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1965."
- 2. Section 8 of By-law No. 1914 as amended is repealed and the following substituted therefor:
- "8. (1) Every owner of an automatic vending machine or every person who makes available, or who helps to make available, for use or operation any automatic vending machine shall obtain a license therefor and shall pay the license fee set out hereunder:
 - (a) For each automatic vending machine for the sale of confectionery when such machine is operated by the insertion of coins greater than one cent - - - \$ 5.00
 - (b) For each automatic vending machine for the sale of stationery - - - \$ 5.00
 - (c) For each automatic vending machine for the sale of tobacco, cigars or cigarettes - \$ 5.00
 - (d) For each automatic vending machine for the sale of any other goods of any kind - \$ 5.00
 - (e) For each automatic vending machine for the vending of amusements of any kind when such machine is operated by the insertion of coins greater than one cent- \$20.00
 - (f) For each automatic vending machine for the sale of confectionery where the said machine is operated by the insertion of one cent coins- - - - - - 2.00
 - (g) For each automatic vending machine for the vending of amusements of any kind operated by the insertion of one cent coins - - - - - - - - 2.00
 - (h) For each postage stamp vending machine - 3 2.00

(2) Beginning on the 1st day of January, 1966, all licenses granted under this By-Law, unless the same become sooner forfeited, shall be for the calendar year current at the time of issuing thereof, and shall expire on the 31st day of December next succeeding the date of issue of same; and no proportionate reduction of license fee shall be made on account of any person commencing or ceasing business after the beginning of the year, except that a person who becomes liable to be licensed after the 31st day of July in any year, shall pay one-half the prescribed license fee."
