## THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY BY-LAW NO. 4884

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 3282, being the "Burnaby Incinerator and Garbage Disposal By-Law 1953".

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY INCINERATOR AND GARBAGE DISPOSAL BY-LAW 1953, AMENDMENT BY-LAW NO. 1, 1966".
- 2. Section 1 of By-Law No. 3282 is amended by adding the following:
  - "(k) "Municipality" means The Corporation of the District of Burnaby.
    - (1) "Engineer" means the Municipal Engineer of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby."
- 3. Section 24 of By-Law No. 3282 is repealed and the following substituted therefor:
- "24. (a) Except as in this By-law provided, no person, firm or corporation shall, unless authorized by the Engineer in writing so to do, collect, remove or dispose of within the Municipality any ashes, garbage, household waste or trade waste.
- (b) Any person, firm or corporation may, upon obtaining the written authorization of the Engineer and paying to the Municipality the sums hereinafter set out, deposit at the Municipal Dump, ashes, garbage, household waste and trade waste (hereinafter in this paragraph referred to as "refuse"). The sums hereinafter set out shall be paid to the Municipality prior to the refuse being deposited at the Municipal Dump and shall be calculated as follows:

Refuse Weighing 100 lbs. or less Nil

Refuse Weighing over 100 lbs. and less than 1000 lbs. \$1.50

Refuse Weighing 1000 lbs. and over 1.50 for the first 1000 lbs., plus \$1.25 for every 1000 lbs. or part thereof over 1000 lbs. "

Read a first time this 31st day of January, 1966.

Read a second time this 31st day of January, 1966.

Read a third time this 31st day of January, 1966.

Reconsidered and adopted this 7th day of February,

1966.
