THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY BY-LAW NO. 4885

A BY-LAW to expropriate certain lands for the construction thereon of a building for the administration of justice and related facilities.

WHEREAS By-Law no. 4764 adopted on the 4th day of October, 1965 authorized the construction and equipping of a building for the administration of justice and related facilities and the borrowing therefor of the sum of \$1,550,000.00 by the issue and sale of debentures.

AND WHEREAS the Council of a district municipality may expropriate real property within the municipality for a municipal hall, and for workshops, storage-sheds, yards and other buildings, structures or premises required for municipal purposes.

AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is a district municipality.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable and in the public interest to expropriate certain lands for the construction thereon of the aforesaid building for the administration of justice and related facilities.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as the "BURNABY EXPROPRIATION BY-LAW NO. 2, 1966".
- 2. The Council does hereby expropriate, in fee simple, take, enter upon and use for the purpose of constructing thereon a building for the administration of justice and related facilities, those parcels of real property situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, more particularly known and described as

- (a) Lot Five (5), Block Seven (7) of
 Lot Seventy-nine (79), Group One (1),
 Plan 2547, New Westminster District;
 and
- (b) Lot Six (6), Block Seven (7) of Lot Seventy-nine (79), Group One (1), Plan 2547, New Westminster District.
- This By-law shall, before coming into effect, be published once in the B. C. Gazette and in a newspaper published or circulating in the Municipality of Burnaby and a certified copy of the by-law shall be filed in the Land Registry Office in the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia.
