

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 4925

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 4742, being  
the "Burnaby Zoning By-Law 1965".

WHEREAS it is deemed desirable and expedient to amend  
"Burnaby Zoning By-Law 1965" as hereinafter set forth.

AND WHEREAS Council has held a public hearing thereon  
after duly giving notice of the time and place of such hearing.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the  
District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ZONING BY-LAW 1965,  
AMENDMENT BY-LAW NO. 22, 1966".
2. Section 6.15(3) of By-Law No. 4742 is repealed and the  
following substituted therefor:

"6.15 SCREENING AND LANDSCAPING

(3) Parking Areas, Loading Areas and Display Yards:

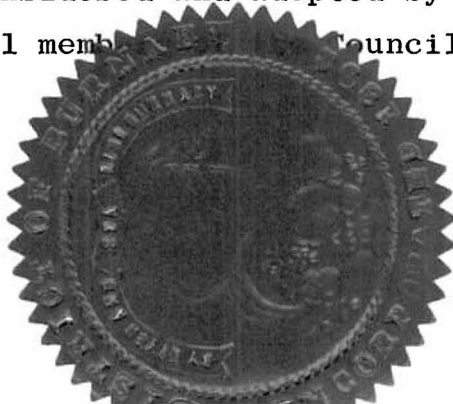
- (a) Any parking area, loading area or display  
yard shall be separated from an adjoining  
street or from a directly abutting lot in  
an A, R, or RM District by a fully and  
suitably landscaped and properly maintained  
strip of not less than six feet in width.
- (b) Screening of six feet in height shall be  
provided and properly maintained:
  - (i) where any parking or loading area  
abuts a lot in an A, R or RM District,  
or is separated therefrom by a street  
or lane;
  - (ii) where any display yard abuts a lot in  
A, R or RM District, or is separated  
therefrom by a lane."

Read a second time this 7th day of March, 1966.

Read a third time this 7th day of March, 1966.

Reconsidered and adopted by an affirmative vote of at least  
two-thirds of all members of Council this 21st day of March, 1966.
