THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY
BY-LAW NO. 5004
A BY-LAW to acquire certain lands for highway purposes.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of
Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 20 , 1966".
2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owners thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other good and valuable consideration, those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being a portion of Lot Seven (7) of Block Twenty-nine (29) of the East Half of Lot One Hundred and Seventeen (117), Group One (1), Plan 1222, New Westminster District, which portion may be more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the Southeasterly corner of said Lot 7, Plan 1222;

Thence N. $39^{\circ} 09^{\prime} 50^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$. along the Southwesterly boundary of said Lot 7, 15 feet;

Thence N. $70^{\circ} 20^{\prime} 40^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E} ., 10.10$ feet, more or less, to a point of intersection with the Easterly boundary of said Lot 7 , said point situate distant 15 feet measured Northerly from the said Southeasterly corner thereof;

Thence $5.0^{\circ} 09^{\prime} 50^{\prime \prime}$ E. along the said Easterly boundary, 15 feet to the point of commencement;

All the said bearings are Astronomic and are derived from the meridian referred to Plan 19931 deposited; the saidparcel containing 71 square feet, more or less, shown outlined red on Plan prepared by Edmund T. Wong, B.C.L.S., dated the 26th day of October,1966, a copy of which is attached hereto.
3. Upon registration of the said deed in fee simple in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia, the said lands shall be established as a public highway.
