THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY BY-LAW NO. 5073

A BY-LAW to acquire certain lands for highway purposes.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 2, 1967".
- 2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owners thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other good and valuable consideration, those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly known and described as follows:
- (a) A Portion of the West Half (being all that portion lying West of a straight line bisecting the North and South boundaries of) Parcel "A" (Explanatory Plan 12434) of Lot 3, Block 3 of Lot 6, Group 1, Plan 7952, New Westminster District, which portion may be more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a point on the westerly boundary of said Parcel "A" (Explanatory Plan 12434, said point being common to the northeast corner of Lot 11, Plan 16019, deposited;

Thence N.0°34'E., along the westerly boundary of said Parcel "Att, 35 feet;

Thence S.88°38'10"E., 75.01 feet, more or less, to a point of intersection with the northerly production of the westerly boundary of Lot 1, Plan 21956, deposited; said point being common to the southwest corner of Lot 2, Plan 21956 deposited;

Thence S.0°34'W., along the aforesaid described line 20 feet;

Thence S.80°01'30"W., 76.29 feet, more or less, to the point of commencement, all the said bearings are Astronomic and are derived from the meridian referred to Plan 21956; said parcel containing 0.047 of an acre, more

or less, as shown outlined red on Plan prepared by E. T. Wong, B.C.L.S., dated the 13th day of January, 1967, a copy of which is hereto attached, and which Plan was deposited in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia, under No.

- (b) The North 33 feet of a portion of the West Half (being all that portion lying West of a straight line bisecting the North and South boundaries of) Parcel "A", (Explanatory Plan 12434) of Lot 3, Block 3 of Lot 6, Group 1, Plan 7952, New Westminster District.
- 3. Upon registration of the said deed in fee simple in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia, the said lands shall be established as a public highway.
