

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 5091

A BY-LAW to acquire certain lands for highway purposes.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 8, 1967".
2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owner thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other good and valuable consideration, those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly known and described as a Portion of Lot Nine (9), Block Six (6) of the East Half of Lot One Hundred and Nineteen (119), Group 1, Plan 2855, New Westminster District, Save and Except Portions of Lots Eight (8) and Nine (9) included on Plan 4957, which said portion is more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the point of intersection of the southerly boundary of the highway right of way defined by Plan 4957 deposited with the easterly boundary of said Lot 9, Plan 2855;

Thence N. 87°04'W along aforesaid described southerly boundary of highway right of way, 10 feet;

Thence S. 43°24'05"E , 14.47 feet, more or less, to a point on the said easterly boundary of Lot 9, said point situate distant 10 feet measured southerly from the initial point of commencement;

Thence N. 0°15'50"E along the said easterly boundary of Lot 9, 10 feet to the point of commencement; all the said bearings are Astronomic and are derived from the meridian referred to Filing 59213 deposited; the said parcel containing 50 square feet, more or less, as shown outlined red on the reference plan sworn correct by Edmund T. Wong, B.C.L.S., on the 13th day of March, 1967, a copy of which is attached hereto.

3. Upon registration of the said deed in fee simple, in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia, the said lands shall be established as a public highway.

BLOCK 6 OF EAST HALF OF LOT 119

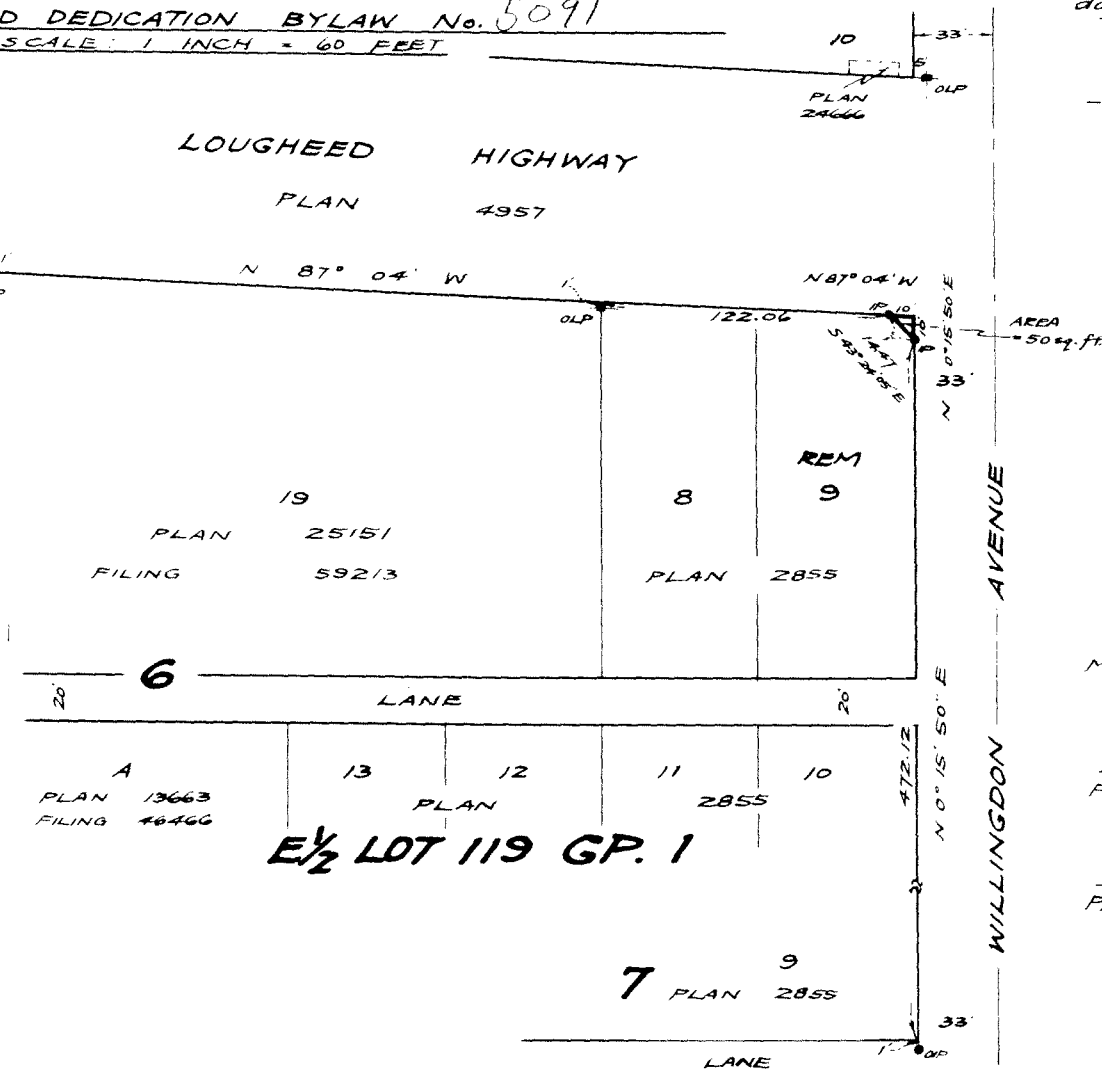
GROUP ONE NEW WESTMINSTER DISTRICT
