

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 5148

A BY-LAW to acquire certain lands for highway purposes.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY ROAD ACQUISITION AND DEDICATION BY-LAW NO. 13, 1967".

2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire from the registered owner thereof by a good and sufficient deed in fee simple, free and clear of all encumbrances, for highway purposes, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other good and valuable consideration, those lands and premises situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly known and described as Portions of Lot Sixty (60) of Lot One Hundred Fifty-Three (153), Group One (1), Plan 26311, which Portions may be more particularly described as follows:

(a) All that strip of land 16.50 feet in width lying parallel to and adjoining the Northerly boundary of said Lot 60 and containing 0.095 acres more or less,

(b) All that strip of land 20.00 feet in width lying parallel to and adjoining the Southerly boundary of said Lot 60 and containing 0.113 acres more or less,

as shown outlined in red on plan prepared by C. D. Underhill, B.C.L.S., on the 10th day of May, 1967, a copy of which is annexed hereto.

3. Upon registration of the said deed in fee simple, in the Land Registry Office at the City of New Westminster, in the Province of British Columbia, the said lands shall be established as a public highway.

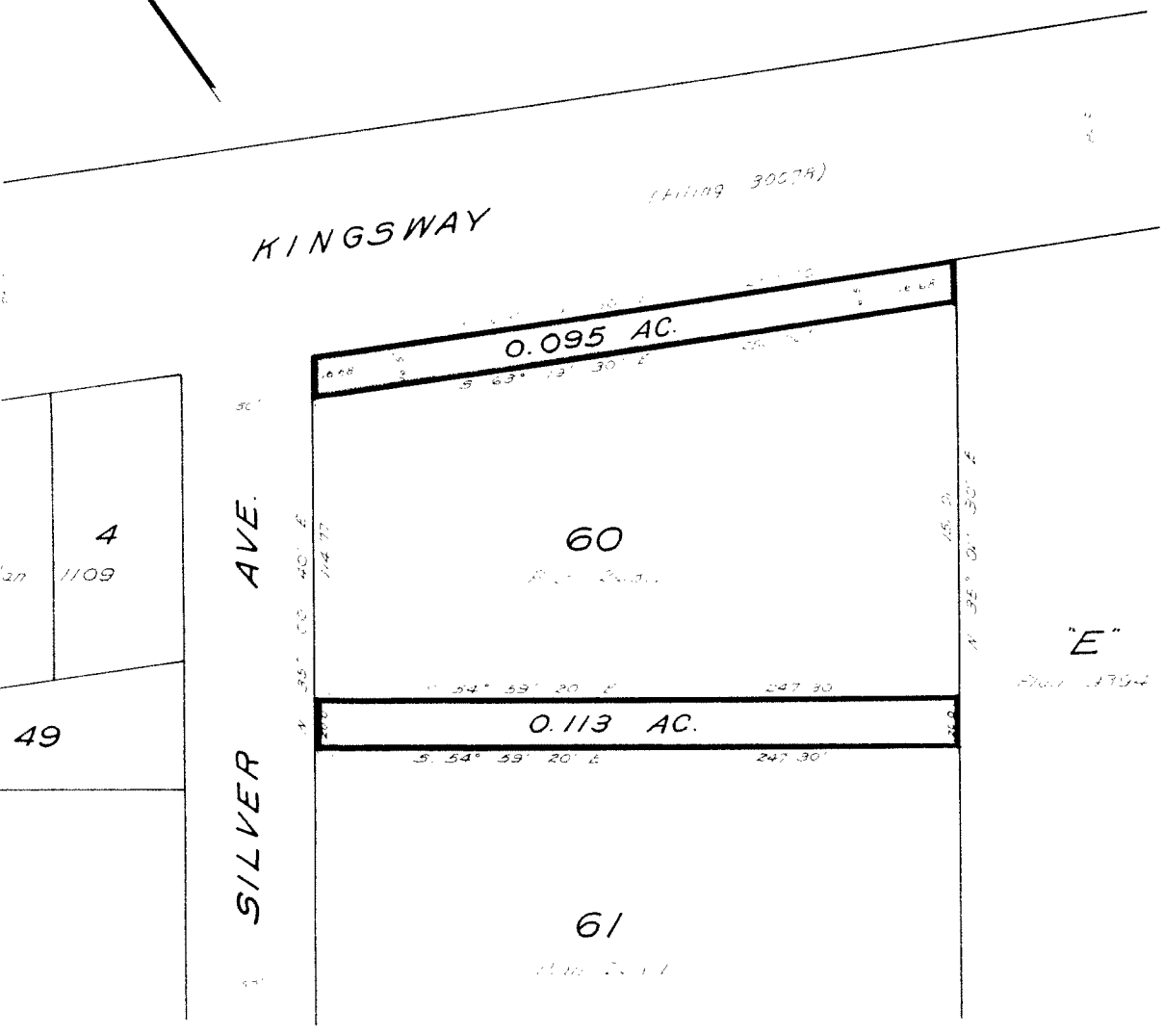
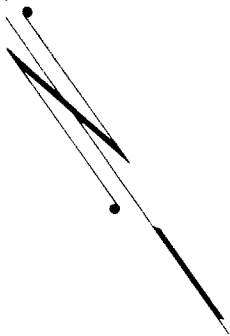
