THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY BY-LAW NO. 5211

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 4839, being the "Burnaby Local Improvement Construction By-Law No. 24, 1965".

WHEREAS the local improvement work more particularly described in By-Law No. 4839 has been constructed in part and the Council deems it inadvisable to complete the work therein described.

AND WHEREAS the frontage-tax assessment roll in respect of the said work has been authenticated.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY LOCAL IMPROVEMENT CONSTRUC-TION BY-LAW NO. 24, 1965, AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1969".
- 2. Section 2 of By-Law No. 4839 is repealed and the following substituted therefor:
 - "2. The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered under the provisions of Part XVI of the Municipal Act to construct a four-foot concrete sidewalk on the North side of Gilpin Street from Royal Oak Avenue to a point approximately 150' west of the access road serving the Municipal Hall and Burnaby Central High School."
- 3. The Assessor is hereby authorized and instructed to revise the said frontage-tax assessment roll in accordance with this amendment.
