THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY BY-LAW NO. 5217

A BY-LAW to regulate pool rooms within the Municipality.

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY POOL ROOMS REGULATION BY-LAW 1967".
- 2. In this By-law unless the context otherwise requires:
 "operator" shall include the person in charge of a pool room;
 "pool room" shall mean a place where equipment for playing pool,
 billiards, snooker or any similar game is kept or provided for
 the purpose of gain or profit.

3. No operator

- (a) shall permit any person under the age of sixteen years to enter or remain at any time in a pool room;
- (b) shall permit any person of the age of sixteen years or over, but under the age of eighteen years to enter or remain in a pool room after the hour of nine o'clock in the afternoon;
- (c) shall permit any person of the age of sixteen years or over, but under the age of eighteen years to enter or remain in a pool room before the hour of four o'clock in the afternoon on any day when public schools are in session in the Municipality.

4. No operator

- (a) shall open or keep open a pool room between the hours of twelve o'clock midnight and nine o'clock in the forenoon of the day following;
- (b) shall leave a pool room in charge of a person under the age of twenty-one years.

- 5. (a) No person under the age of sixteen years shall enter or remain at any time in a pool room.
- (b) No person of the age of sixteen years or over, but under the age of eighteen years shall enter or remain in a pool room after the hour of nine o'clock in the afternoon.
- (c) No person of the age of sixteen years or over but under the age of eighteen years shall enter a pool room before the hour of four o'clock in the afternoon on any day when public schools are in session in the Municipality.
- Every person who violates any of the provisions of this by-law shall be guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine of not more than \$500.00 and in default of payment to imprisonment not exceeding six months.
- 7. By-Law No. 149, being the "Burnaby Pool-Rooms By-Law 1913", and amendments thereto, is hereby repealed.
