

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 5247

A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 4457, being the "Burnaby Local Improvement Frontage-Tax By-Law 1963".

WHEREAS By-Law No. 4382, being the "Burnaby Local Improvement Construction By-Law No. 11, 1962", adopted on the 3rd day of July, 1962, authorized the construction as a local improvement of a twenty foot wide pavement on Napier Street between Douglas Road and Boundary Road.

AND WHEREAS Lot 1 and the West 1/3 of Lot 2, Block 3, District Lot 117W $\frac{1}{2}$ did abut upon the said work and did benefit thereby.

AND WHEREAS By-Law No. 4457, adopted on the 6th day of May, 1963, did charge a portion of the cost of the said work against the said lands for the period of ten years commencing in 1963.

AND WHEREAS the Council did authorize the construction of a traffic barrier at the intersection of Napier Street and Douglas Road for the purpose of traffic safety and the general benefit of the Municipality.

AND WHEREAS the construction of the said barrier has destroyed that portion of the said work abutting upon the said lands and the said lands no longer derive any benefit from the said work.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY LOCAL IMPROVEMENT FRONTAGE-TAX BY-LAW 1963, AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1967".
2. The Council does hereby assume all future levies charged by virtue of By-Law No. 4457 against the said lands.

3. This by-law shall not come into force and effect until approved by the Inspector of Municipalities pursuant to section 614 of the Municipal Act.
